IAGG includes *Her 12th Year: She's not so little anymore* parental coaching guide, the Girl Greatness Rights* of Passage Experience,™ resources for parents and other adults who are nurturing the healthy development of girls ages 10-15, & the IAGG swag items for Great Girls to honor and declare their own greatness.

In May 2022, I was provided with a serendipitous opportunity to rethink the presentation of IAGG's signature program, the Girl Greatness Rites of Passage Experience.™ A "rite of passage" is a

ceremonial event marking a milestone in a person's life¹. Our program is just that, a process of effectively preparing our girls for the transitions into and through two stages of girlhood: preteen and teen years.

With the current political and social climate bringing the rights of girls and women to the forefront, it was important for us to ensure our girls are empowered to stand in their basic human rights.

Since girls have a right to experience life with all the freedoms and benefits to becoming their very best selves; &

Since girls deserve the rights and opportunities to determine their own destinies- spiritually, physically, mentally, and financially, I was led to change the wording of our transitional event to the Girl Greatness Rights* of Passage Experience.™ IAGG will continually strive to provide the resources and experiences delivering the message that *"*every girl deserves to live & thrive."*
